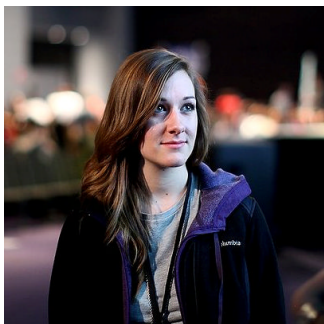
Capital at Jubilee!
